

**Second Public Hearing Notice for
Mifflin County Commissioners and on Behalf of
The Granville Township Supervisors
For the FFY 2021 Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Discretionary or Competitive Program**

Notice is hereby given that the Mifflin County Commissioners and on the behalf of Granville Township plan to submit an application to the Pennsylvania Department of Community and Economic Development (DCED) for Federal Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Competitive funds by February 1, 2022 in order to fund the proposed project of the Hawstone Road Sewer Extension. The project will extend public sewer from approximately Tower Hill Road to Hilti House Lane along Hawstone Road (SR 333). The total grant application will be approximately \$2,816,809.00, which consists of project costs estimated at \$2,657,367.00 and administration costs of \$159,442.00. No displacement of residents is anticipated as a result of this project.

The second of two required public hearings regarding Mifflin County and on behalf of Granville Township FFY 2021 CDBG Competitive program will be held in person at the Granville Township Municipal Building located at 100 Helen Street, Lewistown, PA 17044 on Monday, January 3, 2022 at 4:00 p.m.
